Re: Upcoming open positions on BBBA Board

Regarding your recent notifications for upcoming open positions on the BBBA board in Sofia I enclose my up-to-date CV as requested.

To add further background information on myself - I am a British national, qualified Engineer (MCIOB) with long term presence here in Bulgaria. I first came to work in Sofia in November 2003, (for a 3-month trial period from a UK based consultancy...!)

Professionally I am an experienced Project Manager in the real estate construction industry, having delivered many buildings in Bulgaria (and the wider CEE region) for multi-national & local Investors in the past 20 years based from Sofia as my home town.

I am also the Country Director (MOL) for Optim Project Management ood since 2017, so have considerable real-life knowledge of the challenges in opening and running a local small business here in Bulgaria – from company set up, daily banking & accountancy, labour contracts, insurances, annual regulatory submissions, etc. Which I believe will also be useful experiences for the BBBA role.

On my personal life - I am married (to a Bulgarian wife), with a daughter completing her education in the Sofia school system – so again deep exposure to the local traditions, systems and challenges that may also bring something useful to the BBBA role.

I have been involved with the BBBA since the inception of Optim locally in 2017, albeit with logistical challenges during the 2019-21 period where I was personally responsible for a large project in Belgrade which necessitated time away from Sofia to manage that site on a day-to-day basis.

Currently my projects are locally based in Sofia and thus more time can be allocated for BBBA duties and activities as necessitated by the role as potential Board Member.
